

In addition to ultrafast recovery time, the HEXFRED® product line features extremely low values of peak recovery current (I<sub>BBM</sub>) and does not exhibit any tendency to "snap-off" during the t<sub>b</sub> portion of recovery. The HEXFRED features combine to offer designers a rectifier with lower noise and significantly lower switching losses in both the diode and the switching transistor. These HEXFRED advantages can help to significantly reduce snubbing, component count and heatsink sizes. 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


Fig. 3 - Typical Junction Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage






Fig. 4 - Maximum Thermal Impedance ZthJC Characteristics

Fig. 6 - Typical Recovery Current vs. dl<sub>F</sub>/dt






Fig. 7 - Typical Stored Charge vs. dl<sub>F</sub>/dt




Fig. 8 - Typical  $dI_{(rec)M}/dt$  vs.  $dI_F/dt$ 




Fig. 9 - Reverse Recovery Waveform and Definitions
